## 3. New Business

In other business, the vestry was asked to approve the replacement of the doors to the free-standing garage behind the rectory. It was reported that the existing wooden doors were rotten, cannot be locked and were allowing animals in. The replacement doors would be made out of metal pre-painted white and would come with a keypad for easy locking and unlocking.

Treasurer Cathy Golden said that the \$2,200 needed to fund the door purchase could be taken from the Maintenance Fund.

Louise Beecher moved that the money be appropriated, Lucinda Embersits seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
